Dear Parishioners,

We're entering the last week of June, the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart. It's kind of a shame that, this year, the Feast of the Sacred Heart comes so late in June. Were it at the beginning, it might be a bit easier for us all to remember that June is, indeed, the month of the Sacred Heart. Unfortunately, we can't do much about the date of the feast. It's one of those feasts called "moveable feasts" and, like so many other feasts, depends upon the date of Easter Sunday. No matter what, the Feast of the Sacred Heart always comes on the Friday after the Second Sunday after Pentecost. This is true, regardless of what form of the liturgy one attends.

It's not possible to celebrate the External Solemnity of the Sacred Heart in the Ordinary Form. I checked this last week with Fr. Buggert. So, the anticipated Mass on Saturday will be the 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. On Sunday, however, because such things are permitted in the Extraordinary Form, we will celebrate the External Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. I was fully prepared to celebrate another External Solemnity next Sunday, namely, Ss. Peter and Paul. But that doesn't seem to be the custom here, so, we'll celebrate the Fourth Sunday after Pentecost next week.

However, it's a good bet that I will be celebrating the External Solemnity of Ss. Peter and Paul next Sunday in Naperville, since they are the two patrons of the parish. So, after this weekend, for both the Ordinary Form and the Extraordinary Form, green will pretty much be the prevailing liturgical color until we begin the season of Advent on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of December. Still, there will be two occurrences of white for both forms. The first will be for the Feast of the Transfiguration, August 5 and 6, and then for the Feast of Christ the King on October 29 for the Extraordinary Form and on November 26 for the Ordinary Form.

It looks like we'll have to wait a bit longer for Fr. Hearty to arrive. His recovery from the accident requires a long period of intense therapy. After all, he broke an arm, several fingers and several toes. His doctor won't release him until the end of August, so, we'll have to wait till the beginning of September for him to arrive. I certainly wish it were otherwise.

But, I also have a bit of good news for you as well. My faithful, trusty helpers, God bless them, and I are nearing the end of the data entry saga. I've been on top of things personally in that regard since the beginning of June and we only have four more weeks of catch-up. Hallelujah! God bless.
