Welcome to the new fiscal year! I don't know what made me type that, but maybe some of you don't know

when the diocesan fiscal year begins and ends. Anyway, this new fiscal year looks as good as our old fiscal years. It will probably be better. We can all hope so.

I hope you either did check or will check our diocesan CMAA status. We only have to come up with \$2,031 to make our goal. Of course, I hope we exceed our goal. Remember, we get a 70% rebate on any money paid beyond our set goal. So far, our pledged amount is \$25,814, so, as it is, if we pay that present pledged amount, we'll receive a rebate of \$499.80. We exceeded our goal far better than that in past years. Wouldn't it be nice to get, maybe, \$3.000 back? Sure it would.

They're old friends so things should work out very nicely. Again we thank him so very much for his work and service here. I know we'll miss him very much, but we'll also be happy that he now has a wonderful assignment. But, still, this place is the best, right, my dear family? God bless you all.




